

# Tall Pines Nature Walk

note 2: no bathroom/port-a-pottie at the preserve. Closest bathroom at WAWA half mile away.

**Walk - Park at:** Tall Pines State Preserve

> Bark Bridge Road and Indian Trail, Wenonah, NJ

GPS coordinates: 39.78101, -75.13946

> from Exit 53 on Route 55, take Rte 553 north toward Wenonah. Go 1.5 miles, then left at the traffic light onto Bark Bridge/Salina Rd. Parking is just past the traffic light on the left.

The paved trail winds it's way through a former golf course. No mud or walking thru grass. The trail goes over a creek with a nice bridge. There are a few small "hills" (but remember this was a golf course so how bad can they be). Hiking boots are not needed. Binoculars would be a definite plus.

We will putt along (*get it*) slowly with a guide from the Gloucester Co

Nature Club. The Preserve has 4 miles of trails. We can easily do less. For example the Perimeter Trail (green on map) is a 2.37 mile loop around the boundaries of the park, crossing both bridges.
